The following agreement constitutes a binding contract between Platinum Pocket Bullies, hereafter referred to as 'Breeder' and "Purchaser", identified and described above under Purchaser Information, hereafter referred to as 'Purchaser', for the sale and purchase of one Platinum Pocket Bullies puppy identified and described above under Puppy Information, hereafter referred to as 'Puppy'.

In consideration of a purchase price of \$ _____ of which \$500 is a non-refundable deposit. This Puppy is sold as pet only with limited registration. This Puppy is to be spayed or neutered within a year of their birth date at the Purchasers expense. Registration will be provided once proof of this has occurred. This represents the entire agreement between Breeder and Purchaser in an outright sale and payment is to be made in full before Puppy leaves Breeder's premises.

Health Guarantee

Breeder warrants Puppy to be in good health and free from illness and current on all veterinary recommended vaccines and deworming at the time of transfer to Purchaser. Puppy will stay with Breeder until 8 weeks of age. Puppy will have at least one examination by a qualified

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veterinarian and will receive appropriate worming and vaccinations at Breeder's expense. Breeder requires Purchaser to have Puppy examined by a veterinarian of Purchaser's choice within 72 hours of transfer of Puppy at Purchaser's expense or the health guarantee portion of this contract will be null and void. In the event of emergence of any genetic or congenital disorder, during this exam, which is sufficiently serious in the opinion of at least two licensed, qualified veterinarians, one of whom will be selected by Breeder, to deem Puppy unsuitable as a companion pet or to warrant euthanasia of Puppy, Breeder agrees to:

- A. Replace Puppy with one of equivalent quality within 18 months or at Breeder's option,
- B. Refund the original purchase price.

The Purchaser must provide Breeder with a veterinarian's statement, on veterinarian's letterhead, stating the genetic origin or health condition as well as prescribed treatment plan.

In either of these cases, Puppy must be relinquished to Breeder for placement in a suitable home or euthanized at Breeder's expense if deemed necessary. Veterinary expenses, testing costs associated with replacement Puppy are the responsibility of the Purchaser.

In the event of congenital disorder Purchaser must provide Breeder with all Veterinary records from date listed below. Through the date of discovery of the disorder. Purchaser must also inform Breeder within 24 hours of discovery of the defect.

If the Purchaser chooses to keep the defective Puppy, Breeder will refund 50% of the purchase price, that was originally paid for Puppy and listed on this contract. The 50% refund applies only to the purchase price and does not include veterinary costs. Choosing this option deems the health guarantee portion of this contract null and void.

Purchaser is responsible for scheduling and maintaining regular examinations by a veterinarian of their choice and is encouraged by Breeder to request fecal exams, immunizations and worming schedule starting within one week from the date Purchaser receives the Puppy from the Breeder.

This guarantee is non-transferable.

The Buyer understands that there is no guarantee on final adult weight, size, fur or eye colour.

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Purchaser Responsibility

Purchaser agrees to maintain Puppy in a humane environment with ample shelter, a healthy diet, fresh water, exercise and human interactions and to properly train and care for Puppy. Puppy will not be allowed to roam the Puppy will be socialized and obedience trained appropriately. Purchaser must maintain a schedule for treatment and prevention of preventable diseases, failure to comply will make the health guarantee of this contract null and void. Breeder encourages Purchaser to provide appropriate opportunities for socialization with children, other animals and people.

No Animal Shelter Policy

If at any time during the life of Puppy Purchaser is unable to properly care for Puppy or provide an adequate home for Puppy, Breeder agrees to aid in re-homing Puppy; or accept Puppy back at Breeders location (at Breeders discretion). There will be no refund, or charges toward Breeder or Purchaser in the event that a Puppy must be re-homed. Breeder may charge at their discretion a minimal fee to guaranteed a proper new home for Puppy to cover costs such as food, vet and travel in the event the Puppy is returned to Breeder for a period for time before being re-homed, this amount will be charged to the new Purchaser.
